genes : sent his student, named Philetus, to him. Who, when he had come to James, along with a number of Pharisees : made effort to assert : that Jesus Christ the Nazarene was not the true Son of God : of whom he was calling himself an apostle.

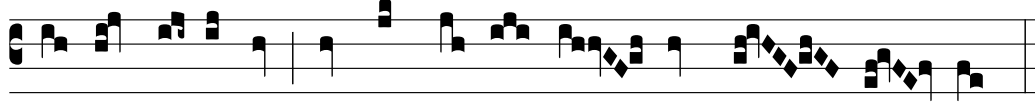

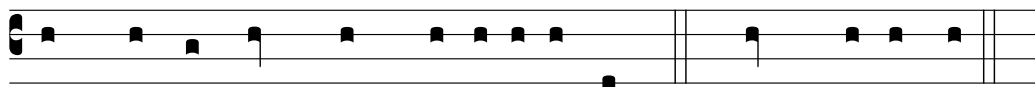

IAmes, acting confidently in the Holy Ghost : negated all his assertions, revealing to them that according to the divine scriptures this was the true Son of God. Returning to Hermogenes, Philetus said to him, Of James, who asserts himself to be the servant and apostle of Jesus Christ : know that thou canst overcome him thyself. For in his name we have seen him casting out devils, giving light to the blind, cleansing lepers, and even

my dearest friends allege to have seen James himself raising the dead. Therefore, let my counsel be pleasing to thee, and come to him and ask for thyself a pardon from him. And know that I shall return to him myself and beg : that I may be merited to be his disciple. And hearing this, Hermogenes was filled with jealousy : bound Philetus : and said, Let us see if thy James can unbind thee from these chains !

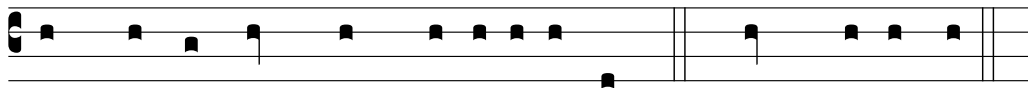

Then Philetus, through his servant, sent word to James. Indeed, at once the apostle sent his facecloth to him. And the moment the one who had brought the facecloth to him touched him with it, he, freed from the magician's chains : came running to James, mocking the magician's sorceries. But Hermogenes, with his magic tricks, conjured up devils : and

instructed them, saying, Go and bring this James to me at once and also Philetus, my student. However, the devils coming to where James was praying : they proclaimed, O James, apostle of God, Hermogenes hath sent us : that we might lead thee and Philetus to him. But as we approached : an angel of God bound us with fiery chains and we are tormented.

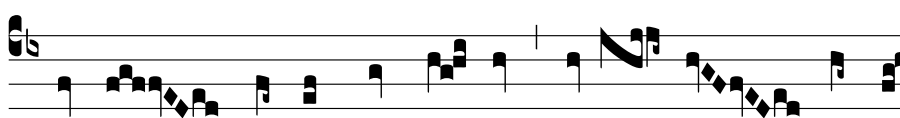
ANd James saith to the devils which Hermogenes sent, In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, may the angel of God set you free : thus that returning to Hermogenes, you should not injure him, but lead him here bound. Who, after they departed, bound him with ropes, hands behind the back : and led him to James. James said to them : Behold Philetus standeth before you : why do you not hold him ? The devils say to him : We cannot even hold

an ant which is in thy bedroom. After this, blessed James said to Philetus : that thou may know this school of Christ to be to return good for evil : since Hermogenes tried to bring thee, bound by devils, to himself : thou shall permit him, bound by the same devils, to go free. When Philetus had done this : the apostle said to Hermogenes, Go free : because it is not of our teaching : that anyone unwilling should be converted.

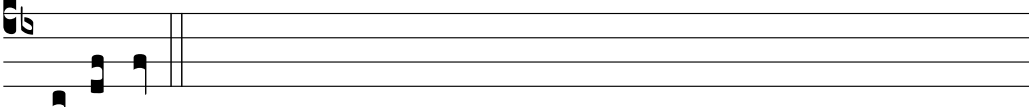

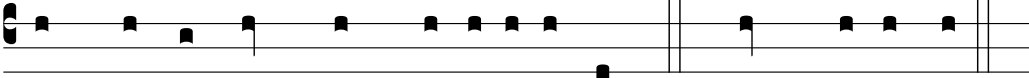

ANd Hermogenes said to James, I know the wrath of the devils : they will capture me and kill me : lest thou will have helped me. The apostle saith to him, Take my walking stick and go with it safely wherever thou will have wished. After this, with praying to James : Hermogenes took hold thus to be perfect in the fear of God : that through him, God would also have brought about mighty works. And after a few days, the high priest Abiathar, seeing Hermogenes and so many people to have believed through

the preaching of the apostle of the Lord : filled with jealousy of riches, incited a dreadful riot : thus that Josias, scribe of the Pharisees, placed a rope around James' neck : and led him to the praetor of Herod : who ordered him to be beheaded. And as he was being led : a certain paralytic cried out to him, O Apostle of Christ : free me from these sufferings. Whence James, In his name, through the love of which I am led to decapitation : arise healthy. Who arose at once : and began to praise the name of Christ.

THe divine lessons adhere to themselves : and frequently one dependeth upon the other : that sometimes the beginnings of the following are more easily understood from consideration of the preceding. We eas-

ily notice that in this lesson : if we briefly attend to the one above. For the Gospel reading recordeth above : And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem. And at once the Gospel adjoins, saying, Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children. The mother of Zebedee's children was the maternal aunt of the Saviour : the mother, evidently, of James and John.

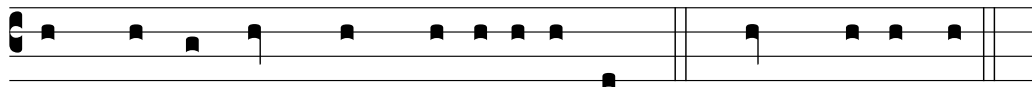

FOr this reason, beloved, the woman is inspired to beg of worthiness for her sons : because after all the Lord had said, And the third day I shall rise again. 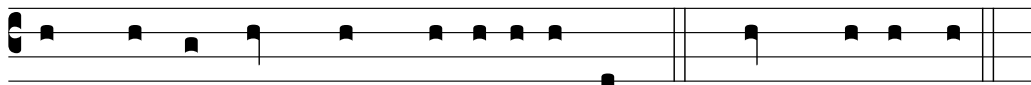

THe Lord asketh them, if they could drink the cup : which he was about to drink, that is, if they could bear the same suffering : that he was about to suffer for them. In which words it is plainly revealed : that first the suffering is endured and then the kingdom is reached. Ye shall drink of my cup, saith the Lord, that is, ye shall endure my suffering. Indeed, concerning James, whose festival we celebrate

today : there is no doubt that he himself had drank of the cup of the Lord, because on this same day he was be-headed by Herod and his martyrdom was consummated. But to sit on my right hand, and on my left : is not mine to give to you, that is, I do not give this by human power. In other words : It is not mine to give to you, that is, to the haughty and overproud : but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared

of my Father : namely, to the humble and meek. Of this, therefore, by the merits and prayers of the blessed apostle James may the divine Grace look upon us : as though we are otherwise, that is, that we may appear as such in

his judgment not as we are now : but as we arose from the baptismal font : that we may receive not what we deserve : but that for which we pray, that is, the life which lasteth forever and ever.

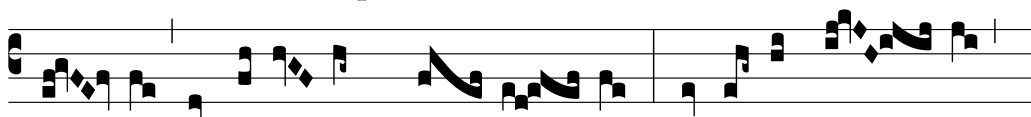
