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Notes.

The hymns translations for the Feast of the Image of the Saviour, and the hymn *Blest Anna, worthily revered*, are printed here for the first time with kind permission of the translator and copyright holder, Matthew Carver.

In this volume *Paschaltide* runs from Easter to the Vigil of Pentecost. *Eastertide* runs from Easter to the Vigil of the Ascension. *Ascensiontide* runs from the Vigil of the Ascension to the Vigil of Pentecost. This follows the practice of *Plainsong Hymn Melodies and Sequences* (PMMS, 1896).

Concerning the hymn *Annue Christi* for Feasts of Apostles and Evangelists, and its proper verses: the Sarum sources suggest that the proper verse comes first, followed by the hymn, *Annue Christe*; however, in modern practice the proper verse usually follows the first verse of *Annue Christe*, after which the remainder of the hymn is sung.

The 'Amens' printed here follow the best available sources. They appear in a variety of forms. Should users of this book prefer, all 'Amens' may be sung to the following standard formula.





