The Centre for Leadership in Learning (CLL) is thrilled to announce the establishment of the Paul R. MacPherson Teaching Fellowships in the CLL at McMaster University. This program, made possible by a generous donation from Paul MacPherson, will identify, through a competitive application process, faculty members who have demonstrated good teaching practices and who show promise of becoming outstanding teachers and of inspiring others.

It will allow Fellows to work for a portion of their time over a one- to two-year period in the CLL, where they will have opportunities to enhance their own teaching by exploring innovative approaches, to collaborate with a network of colleagues on scholarly teaching, and to provide leadership in teaching and learning across campus.

It will also afford them an opportunity to develop and to work through a project leading to a tangible outcome or product that will enhance teaching and learning on campus and/or beyond. Once an individual has been identified for this Fellowship, he or she will maintain this title throughout his/her employment at McMaster.
