The Paul R. MacPherson Teaching Fellowships 2012-13

The Paul R. MacPherson Teaching Fellowships were established in 2011 as the result of a generous one-million dollar donation from Paul R. MacPherson. This program seeks to identify, through a competitive, peer-reviewed application process, faculty members who have demonstrated exemplary teaching practices and who show promise of becoming outstanding educators and of inspiring others.

The Fellowship consists of:

- lifetime appointment as a McMaster University Teaching Fellow;
- up to \$40,000 to work on a project leading to a tangible outcome that will enhance teaching and learning; and,
- release from a portion of the Fellow's typical faculty responsibilities to allow him/ her to spend time working on the project.

Nominations for this award are due to the Centre for Leadership in Learning by February 15, 2012.

Petro-Canada Young Innovator Award

The Petro-Canada Young Innovator Award is funded through a \$250,000 endowment provided by Petro-Canada, and a matching annual contribution by McMaster University's Office of the Vice-President Research.

It is presented annually to one McMaster faculty member and provides an opportunity to build on the connection between research and teaching by engaging undergraduate students in research.

This Award is unique in that it: recognizes the research achievements of an innovative scholar within the first eight years of his or her research career; and, provides funding support to the scholar to enable the active participation of undergraduates in the research endeavour.

The Award consists of: - campus-wide recognition for innovative research achievement by a new faculty member; and,

- \$25,000 support towards a project to actively involve undergraduate students in research.

Applications are due to the Dean's Office in the candidate's Faculty by February 15, 2012.
