Program objectives: Chronic disease prevention and management and health promotion

Eligible Populations



Frequent EMS Callers

≥ 3 calls within 6 months &


≥1 call within 1 month for an ambulance



Lift Assist Callers

≥ 1 call for lift assist within 1 month

CP@home Randomized Controlled Trial







OUTCOMES OF CP@home O







114 fewer 911 calls per 100 people
